I. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 2:37 p.m.

II. Welcome/Introductions

CQM Support Staff welcomed all attendees, made a statement of the meeting's goal, and made individual introductions.

III. AETC Presentation by Sonya O. Brown-Boyne: The Practice of Motivational Interviewing

Sonya O. Brown-Boyne from AIDS Education and Training Center Program (AETC) provided a training session about motivational interviewing to the Disease Case Management (DCM) Network. The presentation consisted of the four processes of motivational interviewing: engaging, focusing, evoking, and planning. She discussed the importance of motivational interviewing and how it helps to reduce barriers to care and treatment services, such as stigma, fear of HIV disclosure, and institutional challenges. Lastly, the AETC representative reviewed how to practically apply the concepts of Motivational Interviewing to care and treatment by using the Stage of Change diagram. The DCM Network provided positive feedback after the AETC training.
