I. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 2:35 pm.

II. Welcome/Introductions

CQM Support Staff welcomed all attendees, made a statement of the meeting's goal, and made individual introductions. Because it is a new fiscal year, they also updated the contact list with the Medical Provider Network.

III. Provide Enterprise Training Assessment Survey

The CQM Support Staff distributed a brief survey to the Medical Provider Network. The purpose of this survey is to understand the barriers in Provide Enterprise (PE) and utilize that information to form a comprehensive training session to help increase PE competency and data accuracy.

IV. Data Presentation: FY22-23 Quarter 4

The CQM Support Staff started the meeting by reviewing the Care Continuum data for Broward County Ryan White Part A and compared it to the Broward County and the state data. Overall, Broward Ryan White Part A has the highest percentage of those virally suppressed, and retention in care is around 73% for all three groups.

The CQM Support Staff presented the fiscal year 2022-2023(FY22-23) quarter 4(Q4) data for the Medical Provider Network. During the presentation, the FY22-23 Q3 and FY22-23 Q4 were compared for the Outpatient Ambulatory (IPCBH) service category. The CQM Support Staff announced to the Network that the retention in care data is inaccurate due to coding issues. GTI is actively fixing this issue in PE and the CQM Support Staff will present accurate retention data for the next meeting when they compare annual data.

Since there were technical issues with retention in care, the overall focus was around prescribed ARV and viral suppression. The staff categorized the Q4 Care Continuum data into three subpopulations: gender, race/ethnicity, and age. For gender, most numbers had less than a 1% deviation between the reporting period. Female (96.48%) and male (93.91%) clients both increased in prescribed ARV, while transgender (85.96%) clients remained the same. For viral suppression, the female (84.92%) clients decrease slightly, while the male (86.33%) clients had a slight increase.

For the race/ethnicity subpopulation, all three subpopulations, Black Non-Hispanic (94.18%), White Non-Hispanic (93.28%), and Hispanic/Latinx (95.50%), showed an increase in prescribed ARV. For viral suppression, White Non-Hispanic (85.21%) and Hispanic/Latinx (92.10%) groups both increased slightly, while Black Non-Hispanic (82.74%) had a slight decrease. Lastly, the CQM Support Staff went over the age group subcategory. For prescribed ARV, the age range 29-38 and 39-48 increased by 2%, while the other groups remained the same in the 90th percentile.

At the end of the presentation, the CQM Support Staff asked the Medical Provider Network if they had any questions about the data review. The CQM team reviewed their current System Mapping Project with the Medical Provider Network. This project aims to help depict and understand how clients maneuver through the Ryan White system. They hope to identify and help implement interventions to address these barriers. After the

discussion, CQM Support Staff announced that AHF would present the next case study presentation.

V. Announcement

Vonn Biggs announced that HIVPC will host a community conversation event on June 16th from 7-9 p.m., located at the Eagle. It is part two of the Leather Kink event last year. CQM Support Staff will send the updated flyer with the registration link.
