I. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 3:03 pm.

II. Welcome/Introductions

CQM Support Staff welcomed all attendees, made a statement of the meeting's goal, and made individual introductions. They updated the contact list with the Network for the new fiscal year.

III. FY23-24 Quarter 3 Care Continuum Data Presentation

The CQM Support Staff, DL, presented Quarter 3 Care Continuum data from this fiscal year as it pertained to the Oral Health Network. CQM Support Staff compared FY23-24 quarter two and quarter three data. The CQM Support Staff informed the network of the exclusion of retention in care measures for quarter three due to data issues in Provide Enterprise. The Oral Health Network showcased numbers in the high 80th to

90th percentile across the entire care continuum, including in care, prescribed ARVs, and viral suppression. For Q3 data, the overall viral suppression for the Oral Health Network increased by 2.2% during the reporting period.

CQM Support Staff examined the data more closely and focused on three subgroups: gender, race/ethnicity, and age. For gender, all three subgroups had an increase in viral suppression. Males and females increased by 2% and 2.5%, respectively, while transgender people increased by 4%. For race, Black non-Hispanic (3.04%), White non-Hispanic group (1.64%), and Hispanic/Latinx (1.5%) had an overall increase in viral suppression between the reporting periods. Finally, the age category with the highest increase in viral suppression was the age group 18-28 (5.89%). The other age groups viral suppression increased as follows: 29-38(3.23%), 39-48(1.52%), 49-58(3.23%), and 59 and older (0.84%).
