Oral Health Network Meeting Minutes

I. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 3:11 pm.

II. Welcome/Introductions

CQM Support Staff welcomed all attendees, made a statement of the meeting's goal, and made individual introductions.

III. Quarter 3 Care Continuum Data Presentation

The CQM Support Staff, DL, presented Quarter 3 Care Continuum data from this fiscal year as it pertained to the Oral Health Network. CQM Support Staff compared FY22-23 quarter two and quarter three data. The Oral Health Network showcased numbers in the high 80th to 90th percentile across the entire care continuum, including retention in care, prescribed ARVs, and viral suppression. For Q3 data, the overall focus was

on retention in care. While prescribed ARV and viral suppression had no notable changes, the overall retention in care for the Oral Health Network decreased by 5.2% during the reporting period.

CQM Support Staff went deeper into the data and focused on three subgroups: gender, race/ethnicity, and age. For gender, males (7.8%) had the highest decrease of retention in care compared to females (4.3%) and transgender (4.2%). For race, the White non-Hispanic group (11.6%) had the highest decrease in retention in care compared to Black non-Hispanic (4%) and Hispanic/Latinx (4.5%). Finally, the age category with the highest decrease in retention in care was age 59 years and older (10.4%). The 18-28 age group had an increase of 2.6% in retention in care, but the group had a 1.9% decline in viral suppression.
